- 1. Salem College of Hairstyling has signed and returned to the Department the Certification Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used, or intends to use, no less than 50 percent of the funds received under section 18004(a)(1) of CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
- 2. Salem College of Hairstyling has received or will receive \$42,481 from the Department pursuant to the institutions Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
- 3. The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act as of today, June 23, 2020, is \$42,481.
- 4. The estimated number of students at Salem College of Hairstyling that are eligible to participate in this program is 29.
- 5. The total number of students who have received financial aid grants under this section is 29.
- 6. Grants were done in three different disbursements and were awarded as follows:
