

1. Salem College of Hairstyling has signed and returned to the Department the Certification Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used, or intends to use, no less than 50 percent of the funds received under section 18004(a)(1) of CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
2. Salem College of Hairstyling has received or will receive \$42,481 from the Department pursuant to the institutions Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
3. The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act as of today, June 23, 2020, is \$10,500.
4. The estimated number of students at Salem College of Hairstyling that are eligible to participate in this program is 20.
5. The total number of students who have received financial aid grants under this section is 18.
6. For the first disbursement of financial grants students that were in enrolled in at Title IV eligible program, were Title IV eligible and were PELL Eligible received \$600.00. Students that were enrolled in a Title IV eligible program and were Title IV eligible but not PELL eligible received \$300.00.
7. Students have received verbal announcements in classes to apply with the school's director for financial grants under the CARES act. Students that did not apply have received either texts or phone calls from the school encouraging them to contact their school director so that they may apply.
